## Mini Projects, Tips or Tricks

### Which Is Which?

To make it easy to tell which size Kemper Kutter I am picking up, I bake clay on the ends for each specific size...Red for large, orange for medium, etc. When I pick up the red heart, I know it is the large one at first glance.

Make a small ball and push it onto the end of the pusher. I baked the whole thing in the oven. You may prefer to use a release agent before you press it on the end. Gently take the tip you make off and bake it as directed on the package.

After you bake them, glue them on the end of your "kutter" and no more searching for matching sizes.
