

“Pumpkin Face Carvings”

Supplies

Clay: Black

Wavy Edge Triangle Cutter (Wilton)

Fancy Edge Scissors of your choice (optional)

5 Black Thumbtacks or Glue

Fake or Real Pumpkin

Roll out black clay (PM2). Cut 3 triangles using the wavy edge cutter.

Draw a mouth with a needle tool lightly in a strip of the black clay. Lightly spray the blades of your scissors with automotive spray. Cut the mouth out using the prepared fancy edged scissors (sometimes found with clay in craft stores but usually found in the scrapbooking section).

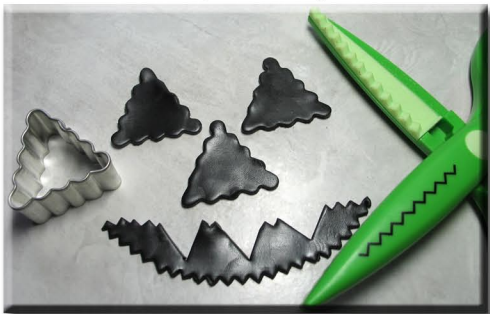
You can press a hole in the center of each piece with a thumbtack or if you prefer, leave the pieces without holes and attach using glue or strong tape.

Bake the pieces following package directions.
Cool and varnish if desired.

Press the pieces into a fake or real pumpkin using thumbtacks or glue.

You have saved the mess of carving a pumpkin and you can use the face again next year!

Use your imagination and make different faces or designs.
