Please Do

1. Create homemade cards designed with love.
2. Add polymer clay embellishments. Please print neatly. (See more info below)
3. Make Happy Cards! Upbeat and Cheerful
4. Use Love Letters in your closing. Examples - "Your friend at Love Letters" or "Your Love Letters Pen Pal"
5. Place each card into an unsealed envelope.
6. Stamps or money for postage is appreciated! Please add it separately.

#2 Details: Please try to keep the clay thin to keep the weight low to help keep the cost of postage down. Also, remember the card should fit in an envelope.

Thank you for wanting to participate in this wonderful Cause! Your cards will be scanned and the pictures will be posted on the web site to help inspire others.

Please take a look at the cards already there to give you an idea of what others have done. You can make similar cards or come up with your own designs! Each card you make can be similar or each one a different design completely. Please do what makes it easiest for you.

Please Don't

1. NO GLITTER on the cards.
2. NO GET WELL CARDS - We do not send cards that say "Get Well," or "Hope You Are Feeling Better".
3. *DO NOT write form letters of "I have, I want, and I like." (See more info below)
4. *Please DO NOT include Bible verses, peace signs, religious stickers or references to the Zodiac on any cards. (see explanation below.)
5. DO NOT date the cards.
6. DO NOT affix postage to the card. You can send stamps separately.

#3 Details: We are trying to avoid "for" letters such as . . . I like ice cream. I like pizza. I like hamburgers.

OR

I have a dog. I want a horse when I get older and I like ponies! (These children may never get to experience what it is like to have an animal or other things typically children might have. So, we always try to remind our volunteers that these are positive reinforcement letters that say "Believe in yourself," "Sending you a great BIG Hug" and "You Shine like a Star."

#4 Details: Love Letters are sent to over 1,200 children. The children are of all religious backgrounds. Love Letters feels that religion is a very personal subject.
