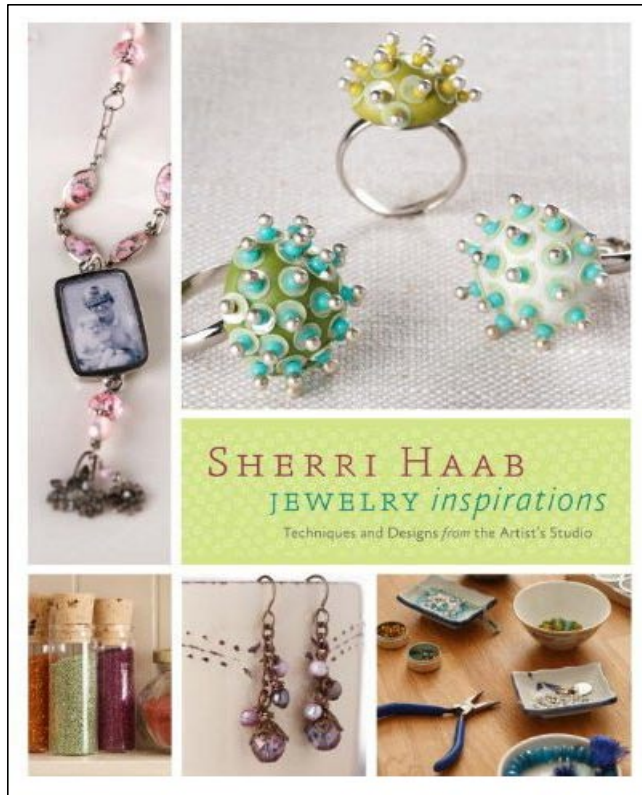


Book Review
